

# FOR THE LOVE

For The Love is a one-night event focused on challenging your students to live a life of purity. Students get messages from the media and many of their peers that its okay to not wait; that they should feel free to have sex as long as they are “safe” about it. They hear from their youth pastors that they need to wait for marriage to have sex. According to SADD, 46% of high school students had sexual intercourse and 13.8% had four or more sex partners during their life. This is almost HALF of all teenagers before they graduate high school. It seems like many of our students have decided to listen to the messages they get from the media and are letting their hormones take control. We want to challenge students to take a stand for purity, to see a generation of students understand that their body belongs to God and that they need to respect themselves enough to wait. The For The Love team will talk to your students about the “why” of waiting and keeping pure and seeking God's best for their lives.

Fuselage takes the typical “True Love Waits” rally and kicks it up a notch. For The Love will feature a band with the speaker, and sometimes a female solo artist if budget allows. The band will kick off the event with a high-energy concert that will lead into a time of worship. The artists will also have some dialog time with the audience talking about their stance on purity and what they has looked like in their lives. The speaker will have an interactive discussion with your students about living a life of purity in today's society and how that is more than just “how far is too far”. We want students to walk away from the night knowing just how much God loves them and that their bodies belong to God. Since our bodies are God's we shouldn't just be giving them away; it's not ours to really give. The speaker will also talk to those students who have already made the mistake of giving themselves away. He will let them know that God can forgive them, that they can have a second chance at living a life of purity. We want to make sure that each student knows that God's grace is given to anyone who wants it and desires to make a change in his or her lives. If we desire to be pure again and walk in God's grace and forgiveness, He will see us as pure. God has the power to put our broken lives back together again. We will encourage students to hold each other accountable in their decision to stay pure. The night will end with a time that will allow students to make a commitment to purity.

For The Love is not just a one time event that comes into your town and then the team leaves and things go back to normal; we desire to see lives truly changed. Our team will be available to talk to students after the event and even months/years later are still encouraging them in their walks with Christ.
