

infuse

Infuse is a four or five night event intentionally designed to challenge students to commit to a deeper walk with Christ. Infuse was born from the concept that students need to live such lives that those around them sense that something different, even foreign, has entered into their life and determines their choices. There are many definitions of the word infuse and many forms that infusing can take. We'd like to present this event to you in light of these definitions. Infuse means "to put into or introduce as if by pouring". We take the first night of Infuse to introduce this concept by introducing students to who Jesus is, and what commitment means as the life of Christ is poured into their lives. This night is filled with energy and gives students a chance to also get to know Terry and the band. Terry speaks on living a life that reflects Christ and challenges students to be serious about committing to God. The second night focuses on worship. The definition of infuse that we use for this night is "to fill or cause to be filled with something". A true lifestyle of worship consists of emptying yourself of everything that is of you and filling up with all God has for you. This evening is powerful! Students will be challenged to get to know their Maker better than ever before as they let go of anything that is not of Him. So many times worship has been taught as the songs that we sing or the things we do before the sermon, but this night will reveal that worship is more than the songs we sing; it is revealed in the way we live our lives. The third night focuses on evangelism. The definition of infuse for this night is "to introduce (a solution) into the body through a vein for therapeutic purposes". Students will learn on this night what it means to be a missionary on their campuses. They will learn practical ways to impact the people that they encounter daily and lead them to Christ. On this night there is also a challenge to apply what was just learned and invite someone to the next night, which is our outreach night. On the fourth night, students are going to be challenged to kick it up a notch based on their current lives and what this means for them personally. Infuse means "to flavor or scent (a liquid) by steeping ingredients in it". This is the night where the salvation message is presented in a practical, simple way, spoken directly from John 3:16. On this outreach night, the band usually plays an energy packed set and it is a fun night that is inviting for the students to bring friends that aren't saved. The last night (if the crusade goes to a 5th night) is an intimate time of communion and commissioning. The final definition of infuse is "to steep or soak without boiling in order to extract soluble elements or active principles". This is going to be a night for students to spend time at the foot of the cross, seeping in God's presence. The band will usually play an acoustic set or you may have a local worship band that will want to play that evening. Communion is taken and students have the time to reflect on what Christ has done for them. They are then commissioned out onto their campuses to be God's servants. Infuse is a cutting edge event designed specifically for student. The desire that we have for Infuse is that the lives of your students would be forever changed. This is an event that is relevant and fresh without all the hype. Everyone involved in bringing Infuse to your area is relational and will minister to your students both on and off stage. We have designed Infuse to be a way for the community to unite as students get to know their Creator better throughout the week.
